#### Portfolio Website

Create a website highlighting your art portfolio. There are many free website to help you do this. Wix.com is currently one of the best. Make sure you choose a login that will make a good URL. Remember colleges will be looking at this.

#### **Requirements:**

1. **MENU BAR** – The menu should be consistent throughout the website. Make sure all the menu links are available on every page for easy navigation. Make sure they all work! Include the following on the menu:
  - a. **Home page**-This page should quickly tell people what the website is about and entice the viewer to click further. All images must be of your own original work. You can use images or parts of images from your portfolio.
  - b. **Bio/Artist Statement** -Write about your art! DO NOT write about where you live or go to school. Remember, ANYONE can read this.
  - c. **Contact – Name and Email ONLY!** NO phone number or addresses
  - d. **Portfolio**
    - i. You can have 1 menu button for the portfolio or multiple buttons. For example it could read “portfolio” or you could use a few buttons to sort your work; “Drawing”, “Photography”, “Graphics” ...
    - ii. You must include a minimum of 12 works of art.
    - iii. Arrange you portfolio to enhance your work. Make sure your pages aren’t too cluttered.
